

Broadband Update and Important Meeting

We are continuing to make progress on our work towards a grant application to the State <u>Broadband Deployment Fund</u> to obtain funding to bring fiber optic internet to our area. Both Woodside and Mountain View Lakes neighborhoods

have joined the project and are in the process of communicating to and surveying their residents. South Park Telephone is our likely Internet Service Provider (ISP) partner.

Staunton Park Visitor Center (You do not need a Park Pass.)

At this meeting David Shipley, Vice President at <u>South Park Telephone</u>, will be in attendance to provide detailed answers to your questions. South Park Telephone has submitted successful grants in the past so Mr. Shipley can provide information based on what worked well. Additionally, Mr. Shipley is on the <u>Broadband Deployment Board</u> which gives him first-hand knowledge of what the Board expects to see in grant applications.

- This is your chance to learn more and really understand:how the technology is likely to work,
 - costs and
 - benefits of this project.

We now have a <u>Facebook Page</u> dedicated to the project. The site was established to create a forum for discussion, to ask/respond to questions/concerns and collect suggestions relative to the Broadband Fund Grant Application. The site is called <u>Broadband Initiative - Staunton, Elk Falls Ranch, Mt. View Lakes & Woodside</u>. Please join the group so you can stay informed.

Additionally, a website has been created - <u>285broadband.com</u> - that will house information, links and documents related to the project and be updated along the way. Thank you to Matt Fontaine from the Woodside neighborhood for building and maintaining the website.

As a reminder, the grant cycle we are working towards is July 15, 2020.
